


Moving Forward Together

2015-16 Program Impact Summary

Serving Guilford and Randolph Counties



QUICK FACTS

- 815** is the number of children served by Big Brothers Big Sisters.
- 745** is the number of volunteers that worked with a child.
- 74,500** is the estimated number of volunteer hours.
- 200** is the average number of youth on our waiting list.



SUCCESS IN SCHOOL

According to **314** final report cards and **292** teacher surveys:

- 68%** of our youth made a C or better grades.
- 38%** made the school A/B Honor Roll.
- 73%** of our youth improved in 2 or more subjects.

PROGRAM OUTCOME EVALUATION

Each year the agency conducts a **Program Outcome Evaluation** (POE) survey that consists of 21 of the 40 developmental assets determined by The Search Institute as vital to a healthy childhood. Big Brothers Big Sisters of America selected the 21 assets they believed are impacted by our mentoring and organized them into three categories - Confidence, Competence and Caring.



According to 292 teachers surveyed:

- 72%** indicated youth improved in **Confidence**.
- 67%** indicated youth improved in **Competence**.
- 74%** indicated youth improved in **Caring**.

According to 132 parents surveyed:

- 84%** indicated youth improved in **Confidence**.
- 64%** indicated youth improved in **Competence**.
- 78%** indicated youth improved in **Caring**.
